

Coalite Regeneration Works

Period Monday 13th March to Sunday 19th March 2017

Main Site Works Undertaken

- Area of sheeted ground to control odour increased to 16,166 square metres.
- 135,400 litres of impacted water collected and removed from site.
- Site visit by students from Imperial College, London
- Medical testing of all site employees results received showing their levels of phenol very low, below that expected in people not exposed at all to the chemical.
- No other significant works.

Monitoring

- A huge amount of monitoring, continuous and intermittent, is undertaken with many environmental properties being measured and reported every 5 seconds. This is done so that if the site works cause an unacceptable impact immediate action can be taken to address the cause.
- As is to be expected given the low scale of the works being undertaken no significant environmental impacts were detected either on site or off site.
